



## Seven-Eleven and Iwatani to open hydrogen fuel stations in Japan, Japan Times says

**Seven-Eleven Japan Co. has joined energy company Iwatani in an effort to open convenience stores that will offer hydrogen for vehicles in Japan, the Japan Times reported in early December.**

The plans include opening at least two stations next year, the newspaper said. Seven-Eleven also wants to use hydrogen from the stations to obtain power for the stores, the media added.

Seven-Eleven did not immediately reply to an email seeking confirmation. The information could not be immediately found on either the English web pages of Iwatani or of Seven Eleven.
