Fit for AFIR?

Starting from April, all new charging stations must enable card payments due to the EU-wide introduction of the **Alternative Fuels Infrastructure Regulation (AFIR)**. Hecronic explains what this means for operators in concrete terms.



From April 13, 2024, all new charging stations must enable card payments. The reason for this is the EU-wide **introduction of the Alternative Fuels Infrastructure Regulation (AFIR)**. But what does this mean in concrete terms?

- Public DC fast charging stations with a power of 50 kW or more must be equipped with either a card reader or a contactless payment option.
- Charging stations with lower power require a dynamic QR code.
- Connection to a backend system and secure data transmission are necessary.
