lowa is the nation's leader in renewable fuels production. Iowa has 43 ethanol refineries capable of producing more than 4.4 billion gallons annually, including 55 million gallons of annual cellulosic ethanol production capacity. In addition, Iowa has 12 biodiesel facilities with the capacity to produce nearly 400 million gallons annually.
